How to Access the venue, Kyoto

Kyoto is conveniently accessible via the Kansai International Airport (KIX). There are direct flights from international cities and major hubs in Asia and other areas to KIX.

From Airport KIX to the venue Kyoto Research Park (KRP), or additional information of international gateways.

- ☆ About 75 minutes by Airport Shuttle Train “Haruka” from KIX to Kyoto Station.
- ☆ About 120 minutes by Limousine bus from KIX to Kyoto Station.
- ☆ About 5 minutes from Kyoto Station by train (JR Line (Sanin main line)) to KRP.



Kyoto Research Park (KRP)

KRP hosts many international and domestic academic conferences, seminars, workshops, various examinations, exhibitions, etc. KRP is not only easily accessible from Kyoto Station, but also has a high-speed and stable network environment where web conferencing and live streaming can be performed smoothly and comfortably.

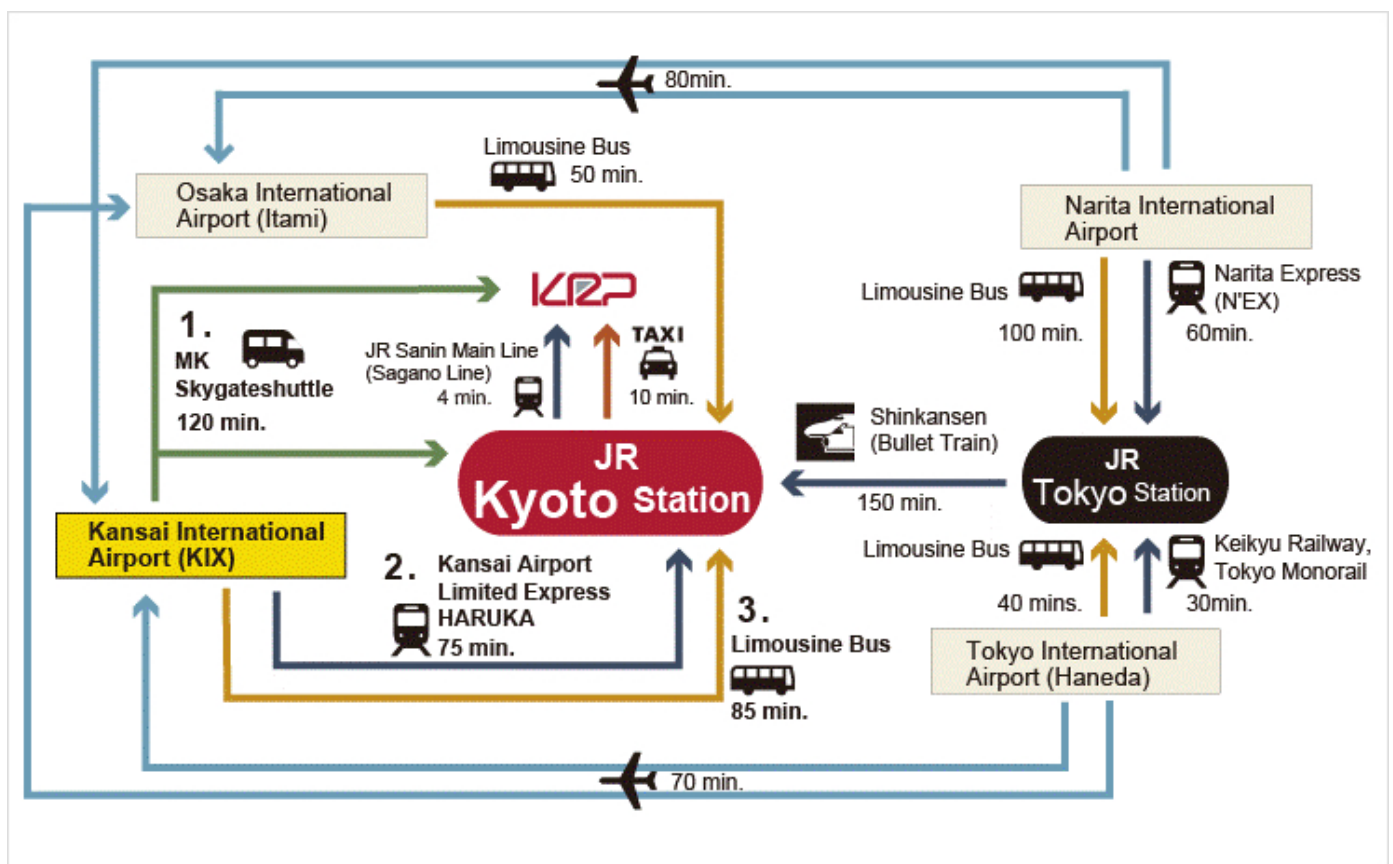
