All cancellations (in person and virtual) have to be sent in by email to [conference@ajaj.info](mailto:conference@ajaj.info) before 24:00, October 31, 2023 (by the time the date changes in Japan time). A refund of the total amount paid minus the administrative fees per registration is applicable. No refunds are possible after this date. If a participant fails to attend, no refunds will be available.

In case you have registered but can't attend in person to the conference in Kyoto, due to force majeure (uncontrollable events), you will be able to attend virtually.
